THE BENEFITS OF DOUBLE DIPLOMA MASTER PROGRAMS:

- to bring into compliance with all the main objectives of the Bologna process (comparable degrees and programs, methods and technologies of education quality assessment, academic mobility, diplomas recognition, competitiveness of education);
- to develop and increase students and professors academic mobility.



DDMPs ARE PERCEIVED AS THE WAY TO:

- access to new educational markets;
- improve recruitment campaign of high potential and international students;
- make greater the collaboration opportunities between faculties at the home institution and partner institution;
- increase the University reputation and ranking as an international university. This is accomplished by deliberately collaborating with partners of equal or greater status;



DDMPs ARE PERCEIVED AS THE WAY TO:

- capacity building and status building opportunity for the faculty\teaching staff in the home university, and in general in the education sector of the country;
- the potential for the development of a new type organizational culture in the educational environment;
- increase internationalization and international visibility of national institution.



CHALLENGES IN SETTING UP DDMPs:

- The lack of balanced international and domestic legislation for establishing and implementing of DDMPs;
- The lack of regular state support for the creation and development of DDMPs and for expanding academic mobility programs;
- The absence of qualified and timely passport and visa support for the staff involved in academic mobility implementation;



CHALLENGES IN SETTING UP DDMPs:

- Low level of foreign languages competences of the faculty and the students;
- Underdeveloped students' campus infrastructure;
- Ineffective marketing policy in recruiting and enrolling the students;
- No appropriate effective mechanisms for the search of external sources of financing;
- Difficulty in understanding of a different type of mentality and culture.



FINAL STATEMENTS

- To establish academic counseling services at the faculties to assist students in choosing DDMPs, curriculum and to make an individual educational track;
- To organize information and training seminars on students academic mobility;
- To develop online DDM programs to facilitate program mobility;
- Provide cutting-edge scientific equipment and a community of highly skilled scientists to complement the academic environment of the university.
