From Economy society to...

- The economies of world countries are strongly interlinked, which provides the liberalization of the movement of goods, workers, capital, investment, and technology.
- The nucleus of this process can be found on the European continent, where for almost seventy years, a great experiment has been conducted which addresses the question of how to integrate states economically, while leaving them partially politically independent.
- New era of virtuality (soft law) emerges via informational expansion

Twilights of legal landscape

- A significant achievement on this road was the creation of the European Union – a legal entity, whose institutions possess sufficient competence to tackle all issues relating to trade and financial matters, and which fosters the development of the integration process.
- Moreover, these institutions are vested with the right to construct the corpus of EU law as a supranational legal system – the cornerstone of European integration.
