

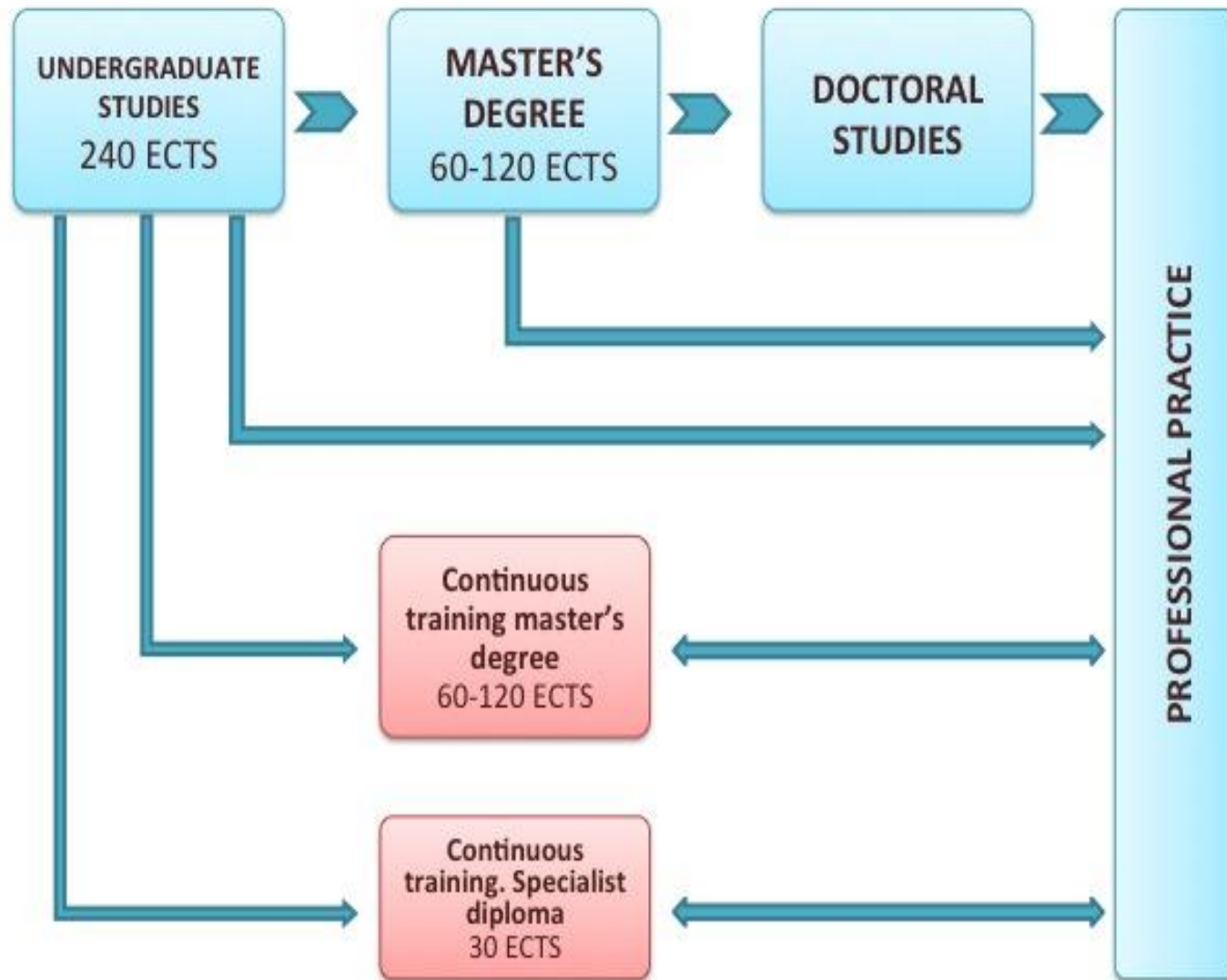
UKRAINE IN THE BOLOGNA PROCESS

In 2005, in an effort to raise the international legitimacy of its higher education system, Ukraine joined in the Bologna Process. It was the first step to involve: - redesigning the curricula - shifting to a three-cycle degree structure - submitting to cross-national mechanisms of quality assurance - shifting from teacher-oriented to student-oriented instruction.

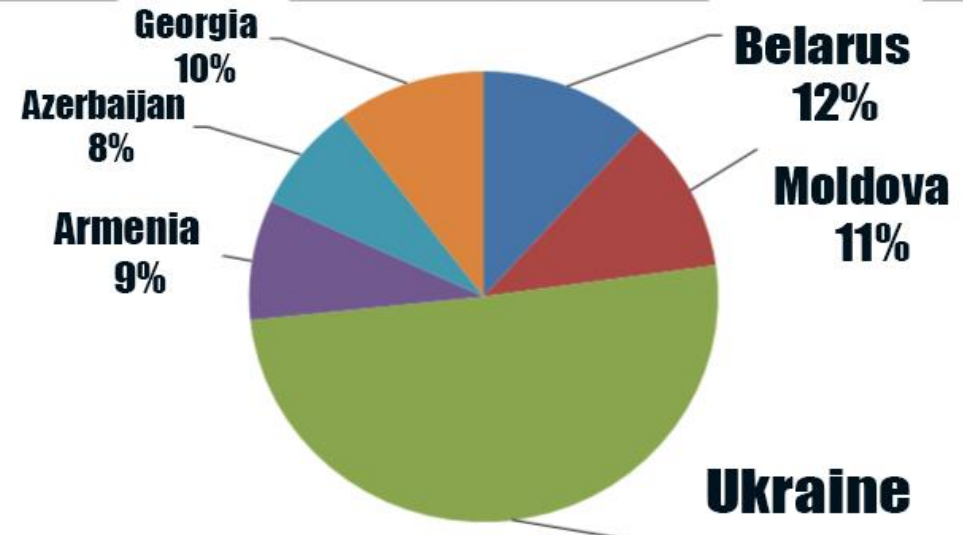
HIGH EDUCATION STRUCTURE IN UKRAINE

The University has the highest — IV level of accreditation and a Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine license for training legal specialists of all educational qualification levels and academic grades, namely "senior specialist", "bachelor", "master", "philosophy doctor". In addition, the University trains sociologists, politologists, journalists, specialists in the sphere of advertisement and public relations, innovative activity and consolidated information. Combination of science, training and education is a necessary precondition of the comprehensive approach to modern specialists' training. Early professional orientation and the step-by-step training comprise the essence of the 21st century education.

The University's accession to the European Universities' Association elevated the students' training to the European and international standards, provided for the recognition of the University's diplomas worldwide and allowed joining the Bologna process.

International cooperation is one of the most important directions of the activity of the National University "Odessa Academy of Law". The development of international ties and cooperation is carried out in the context of integration into world and European educational environment.
